


Day 1: Friday, February 13: Havana City

Morning flight from Miami to Havana. Transfer to Hotel Meliá Habana. Welcome dinner at Artist Kadir Lopez's studio. Cuban cuisine,




Day 2: Saturday, February 14: Havana City

Morning city tour of Old Havana's Four Plazas. Followed by a lecture Cuban Music Specialist, Dr. Olavo Alén Rodriguez. Lunch and music in Hotel Florida (International cuisine. Afternoon Salsa lessons at local dance school. Dinner on your own.



After breakfast, we'll take a driving tour of El Vedado neighborhood, followed by a morning Rumba Workshop. Then visit Callejon de Hammel, an open air religious sanctuary in the Cayo Hueso neighborhood. Meet local artists and their murals. Enjoy Afro-Cuban rumbas in the street. Lunch in the Atelier.

Afternoon music and dance performance by Okan Tomi . Evening supper at La Guarida Restaurant.



Morning visit to Vedado and Havana Moderna. Then a music lecture with Pablo Menendez lecture. Lunch at El Aljibe criolla cuisine (Cuban cuisine). Followed by viewing a private rehearsal by the Folklorico Nacional de Cuba. Dinner on your own.















Day 5: Tuesday, February 17: Havana City

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll take a nature tour to Las Terrazas in Pinar del Mar and visit Buena Vista Coffee Plantation. Lunch at a typical rural house followed by visit to the San Juan River. Dinner on your own. Evening visit to Jazz Club La Zorra y el Cuervo.



Day 6. Wednesday, February 18: Havana City/Matanzas/Varadero

Check out of Hotel Meliá Habana. Ferry ride across the Bay of Havana to the city of Regla. Continue to the city of Matanzas. Tour of workshop and archives of Ediciones Vigía, an artisanal press producing hand-made books. Lunch at Restaurant Velazco (International cuisine). Folkloric Music Presentation. Continue to Varadero and check-in to the Hotel Melia Varadero. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.



Day 7: Thursday, February 19: Varadero/Havana City

Breakfast and lunch at the hotel. Depart Hotel Melia Varadero and transfer to Havana. Museo de Bellas Artes international Art Collection, Capitolio, Central Park and Prado. Check in to the Hotel Melia Habana. Dinner at La Ferminia (International cuisine) with a music presentation by Grupo TradiSon.





Day 8: Friday, February 20: Havana City

After breakfast we'll check out of Hotel Meliá Habana. Visit Camerata Romeu for a music rehearsal. Lunch at Paladar Los Mercaderes (International cuisine). Transfer from a Havana hotel to the airport Depart Havana for Miami.
