- Day 2: Sunday, June 16: Arrive at Oslo Airport (OSL). Take "Flybussen" to downtown Oslo. Lee will meet you in our hotel lobby at 6:00 p.m. Short walking tour of Oslo and welcome dinner. Overnight at the hotel.
- Day 3: Monday, June 17: Morning sightseeing of Oslo includes Vigeland SculpturePark, Holmenkollen Ski Jump, and the Royal Palace. Drive to Drøbak whereLee lived before moving to the USA. Guided tour. Evening dancing in Oslo.
- Day 4: Tuesday, June 18: Depart Oslo. Drive through scenic Telemark past mountains, farmlands and stave churches. Arrive at Karin Brennesvik's house and dance center in Hovin. Dance instruction, walking tours, visits to local folk artists. Lunch, dinner and overnight in dance center
- **Day 5: Wednesday, June 19:** Meet local folk artists and dance with local dance experts. More local excursions. Breakfast, lunch and dinner included.
- **Day 6: Thursday, June 20:** Leave Hovin and drive over snowy mountains to Rauland folkemusikkakademi. Dance in the evening. Dinner included.



- Day 7: Friday, June 21: Leave Rauland Breathtaking ferry ride across Hardanger Fjord.Continue past gorges, rivers, and waterfalls. Arrive and register at the Hotel Bergen Brygge.Possibly meet and dance with local dancers (or local sightseeing or shopping.)
- Day 8: Saturday, June 22: Sightseeing tour of Bergen including Hanseatic warehouses, and Viking Hall. Visit Troldhaugen, home of composer Edvard Grieg. Lee Otterholt, born in the USA of Norwegian-American parents, has lived and worked most of his life in Norway as a professional dancer, teacher, and choreographer. He founded the Center for International Folk Dance in Oslo; he was also professor of dance folklore at the Norwegian National College of Ballet, and University College of Oslo. Lee established folk dance and performing groups in Norway, taught at festivals and workshops throughout Europe, United States, and East Asia, and is the author of folk dance and instructional manuals used in Norwegian schools. Lee was one of the choreographers for the Opening Ceremony of the Winter Olympic Games in Lillehammer.

Air Transportation: International air not included except as noted.

Reservations: Deposits and Payments: Deposit of \$200 per person is required at time of reservation. Balance is due 90 days prior to departure date.
