## ITINERARY

**WEDNESDAY JUNE 10: Fly to Warsaw.** Transfer and check-in to our downtown hotel.

<b>Day 1</b>	THU JUN 11	Warsaw	Bus Tour with local English-speaking guide of the major city attractions and a folk evening with a Warsaw performing ensemble.
<b>Day 2</b>	FRI JUN 12	Warsaw	Walking tour of Old town, riverside and Jewish ghetto with locals. Exhibition and presentation of Polish folk costumes.
<b>Day 3</b>	SAT JUN 13	Olsztyn	After a visit to the Chopin Museum in Żelazowa Wola we head to Olsztyn for an evening with Justyna under the stars enjoying horse-drawn wagon rides, a bonfire, a feast of food and drink and games and dancing.
<b>Day 4</b>	SUN JUN 14	Gdańsk	We visit Olsztyn in the morning and Malbork Castle (home of the Teutonic Knights) in the afternoon before enjoying an evening on the seaside in Gdańsk.
<b>DAY 5</b>	MON JUN 15	Gdańsk	Guided tour of the Tri-City Area of Gdańsk, Gdynia and Sopot including a stop at Westerplatte where World War II began and the Molo which is the longest wooden pier in the Blatic Sea built in 1827 and folk dancing
<b>DAY 6</b>	TUE JUN 16	Toruń	An in-depth look at this beautiful medieval walled city along the Vistula River and home to Nicolas Copernicus.
<b>DAY 7</b>	WED JUN 17	Kraków	We'll end the day in our beautiful hotel in the ancient capital of Kraków after a visit to see the Black Madonna at Jasna Góra in Częstochowa and a heart-wrenching guided tour of the Auschwitz-Birkenau Museum
<b>Day 8</b>	THU JUN 18	Kraków	Guided tour of Kraków sites – Folk evening with local group
<b>Day 9</b>	FRI JUN 19	Kraków	Ethnographic Museum and Costume shopping
<b>Day 10</b>	SAT JUN 20	Zakopane	Morning tour underground in the famous Wieliczka Salt Mines before driving up into the Tatra Mountains to the resort town of Zakopane
<b>Day 11</b>	SUN JUN 21	Zakopane	A day on the Dunajec River – Souvenir shopping and Mountain folklore
<b>DAY 12</b>	MON JUN 22	Warsaw	We head back to the Capital for some final shopping and an evening of good food and folk dancing as we say our farewells
